## Session 1: Loving through listening and questions

Key question: How can we better know the people God has sovereignly placed in our lives?

Aim: To see that we love people as we pay attention to their lives, listen well and ask good questions. This care can lead to opportunities to share the gospel with them.

Intro: How does it make you feel when someone has been really listening to you and wants to know more about the things you are interested in? (And the opposite?) **3mins** 

Bible text: Matthew 22:34-46

Jesus' life was marked by listening and asking questions. His teaching style has been described as 'questioning evangelism'.

In this chapter Jesus has been addressing malicious questions aiming to discredit him. The way he listens and then asks questions reveals his authority.

Discuss together (a) How well Jesus listens (b) the effectiveness of his questions (c) what we can learn from him **12 mins**
